# JORUM

## What is JORUM?

JORUM is a JISC-funded collaborative venture in UK Higher and Further Education to collect and share learning and teaching materials, allowing their reuse and repurposing, and standing as a national statement of the importance of creating interoperable, sustainable materials.

JORUM consists of two services: JORUM User and JORUM Contributor.

JORUM User provides access to the shared repository of resources. Teaching and support staff in institutions that take this service will be able to find, preview, download, reuse and repurpose materials for use with learners in their institution. They will also find a collection of teaching support, staff development and case study materials to assist them in using the learning materials with students.

JORUM Contributor opens up JORUM to any institution or project team that wants to share its learning and teaching materials with colleagues in the UK. JORUM will hold grant-funded materials and materials that have been developed by institutions.

## Resources in JORUM

Resources will depend on whatever is contributed to the repository by the community, but are likely to include:

### Learning Resources

Resources that teaching staff can use with learners, in blended learning, classroom or online learning activities. Examples include single assets (documents, images, video clips,

diagrams) or more comprehensive learning objects (interactive units made up of several elements such as images, text and self-assessment exercises).

## Teaching Resources

Resources of this type support teaching staff in doing their job. Examples include tutor guides, lesson plans, schemes of work and staff development materials.

## How to Access JORUM

JORUM is FREE for UK F/HEIs. Access to JORUM User will require an institutional user agreement with JISC and individual registrations. Access to JORUM Contributor will require an institutional deposit agreement and individual registration.

## User Support

A range of user documentation and promotional materials is available in print and video format for use online and to download. The materials cover a range of JORUM service features, tailored to the needs of all users.
